**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER JONATHAN E. PERLMAN'S MOTION TO COMPEL  
TURNOVER OF BMW BY JEREMY LEE MARCUS**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon Receiver Jonathan E. Perlman's Motion to Compel Turnover of BMW by Jeremy Lee Marcus (**D.E. 182**), filed on **December 27, 2017**.

THE COURT has considered the motion, the response pertinent portions of the record, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is

**ADJUDGED** that the motion is GRANTED. The Receiver indicates in an "Agreed Order" that Defendant Jeremy Marcus no longer objects to turning over his BMW and has agreed to a timeframe and location to turn over his vehicle to the Receiver. Neither side has filed a motion to that effect nor has Jeremy Marcus retracted his opposition to the motion to compel on the docket. Nevertheless, the Court grants the motion and finds it is appropriate for Marcus to turn over the BMW i8 to the Receiver consistent with this Court's Preliminary Injunction ordering the Receiver to take exclusive possession over all Receivership Defendants' assets.
