**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S AMENDED MOTION TO COMPEL  
TITAN FUNDING, LLC TO COMPLY WITH PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon the Receiver's Amended Expedited Motion to Compel Titan Funding, LLC, to Comply with the Preliminary Injunction and Execute an Assignment of Receivership Assets (D.E. 470), filed on March 9, 2020.

THE COURT has considered the motion, the pertinent portions of the record, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is

**ADJUDGED** that the motion is **GRANTED**. Titan Funding, LLC must, no later than March 14, 2020, comply with paragraph X.D of the Preliminary Injunction Order (*see* D.E. 21) by providing to the Receiver a fully-executed assignment.<sup>1</sup> The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce this Order. It is further

**ADJUDGED** that the Receiver's Expedited Motion to Compel (D.E. 469) is **DENIED AS MOOT** in view of the Receiver filing an Amended Motion.
